Sexual Predators Unit – Pres. Salvatore reported on memo received from Freeholder Rainear regarding South Woods Prison to house sex predators and meeting held May 7, 2007. Discussion was held, Resolution submitted in opposition for tonight.

Mayor reported march scheduled for May 19, 2007 at 11 a.m. at South Wood Prison.

Taxi cab fare increased – Pres. Salvatore presented request from Mr. Teodoro Martinez, Go US Cab Transport, for increase in rates, Mr. Martinez not present at the time, item held until he comes.

CROP Walk – Pres. Salvatore presented correspondence from First Presbyterian Church, For CROP Walk scheduled for Sunday, May 20, 2007, 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. along with the walking route and appropriate departments have been notified.

Water meter Bid – Mun. Solicitor Baker reported on discrepancy in bids received and recommended reject and re-advertise which Council agreed upon.

Proclamation Fibroyaplasia Ossifixans Progressive (FOP) – Pres. Salvatore presented Proclamation regarding the support and funding research for this condition which Council agreed to support by Resolution at May 15, 2007 Council meeting.

Amending Zoning Ordinance Chapter 370 – Pres. Salvatore presented ordinance for redevelopment from Sarah Birdsall – Council still reviewing.

Abandoned Properties Rehabilitation Act – Distributed for Council review excerpt from the Millville City Code

Council Meeting May 15, 2007 – Clerk reviewed items for the meeting.

Summer Schedules – Discussion concerning summer schedule at the conclusion it was agreed to only hold meetings on first and third Tuesdays fro the months of July, 2007

August 2007 and June, 2008.

Also this June, 2007, meetings scheduled for second and fourth Tuesdays would be cancelled.

GO US Cab & Transport – Mr. Teodoro Martinez presented his request for increase in rates for taxicab transport, discussion was held at the conclusion Council stated they would take his request under consideration.

#### PUBLIC PORTION

Upon motion by Mr. Spence and second by Mr. Kelly to open the meeting to the public for any one desiring to address Council which motion was carried.

Pres. Salvatore opened the work session for any one desiring to be heard at this time.

Mr. Michael Zapolski, West Avenue, questioned if Ordinances regarding Oak Street, and Cohansey Street had been signed. He was informed that they are on for second reading, May 15, 2007, after which they would be signed if adopted.

Mr. Don Renzey, Institute Place, registered complaint concerning a neighbor, their children, trash and noise also Mr. Hickman and another neighbor accompanied him regarding the matter. Council stated that the matter would be investigated.

No one else desiring to be heard, it was moved by Ms. Riley and second by Mr. Kelly to close the public portion of the work session which motion was carried.

Pres. Salvatore closed the public portion of the work session.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Upon motion by Mr. Spence and second by Ms. Riley RESOLUTION NO. 261-06, authorizing an executive session to discuss contract, litigation and real estate which motion was carried. The original resolution may be found in the Resolution Book.
