Council

Mr. Kelly commented he was in receipt of the solicitor's Memo regarding the referendum but expressed concern over sex offenders being placed in Bridgeton along with the expansion of the prison and asked for a resolution requesting referendum on ballot protesting same, it was agreed to wait for Mr. Baker, Solicitor, for further discussion and information.

Ms. Riley reported on Court House Hill doing a surveying the community which was recommended by Triad Associates also stated that they are looking for help.

Mr. Baker, Mun. Solicitor, entered and responded to Mr. Kelly's concerns that due to time frame most likely the referendum would not make the ballot. But could use other methods along with a resolution, letters could be sent. Discussion was entered in regarding the matter at the conclusion the Solicitor was asked to prepare a resolution along with a petition to be signed for the October 2, or September 25, 2007 meeting.

Admin. Liston commented that at the next Work Session, September 25, 2007, he would also like to include a Budget Session.

Mr. Salvatore commented on Memo of September 13, 2007 he received regarding registration of vehicles, and also reminded everyone the Route 49 Bridge repair will start October 12, 2007 and had a question concerning bill on the Schedule of Bills, as he would like to keep business in town.
