

RESIDENT ID CARD City of Bridgeton INFORMATION SHEET

Resident ID cards shall be issued to any City of Bridgeton resident that is able to meet the requirements for establishing their identity and residency, pursuant to §284-8(C).

In order to obtain a Resident ID Card from the City of Bridgeton, applicants will be required to produce one or more of the following documents at the time of application to establish their identity for a total of **at least 4 points** according to the table below.

The following are ACCEPTABLE FORMS to establish proof of Identity :		
Document Points	Information Shown	Document Examples
4 Points	Photograph, Name, <u>and</u> Date of Birth	Passport; Consular, or Permanent Resident ID card, License, Visa
3 Points	Name and Date of Birth	Birth Certificate, License
2 Points	Photograph and Name	License, Military ID
1 Point	Name only	Social Security or EBT card

To establish residency an applicant must present **at least 2 of the following items** showing both the applicants name and residential address located within the city limits.

- Utility Bill, Local Property Tax Statement, Mortgage Payment receipt, Bank Account Statement.
- Proof that the applicant has a minor child currently enrolled in a school located within the city, employment pay stub; jury summons or court order.
- Federal or State income tax or refund statement, an insurance bill (homeowners, renter's, health, life, or automobile insurance).
- Care Address Letter confirming residency. A letter prepared by a government agency, hospital, non-profit organization's letterhead authorizing the use of their address for mailing purposes by an individual.

The fee for a resident ID card shall be **\$15.00 for adults** and **\$8.00 for minors, veterans, disabled and senior citizens** pursuant to §284-7(D). **NOTE: Cash only or Money order made payable to the City of Bridgeton.**
