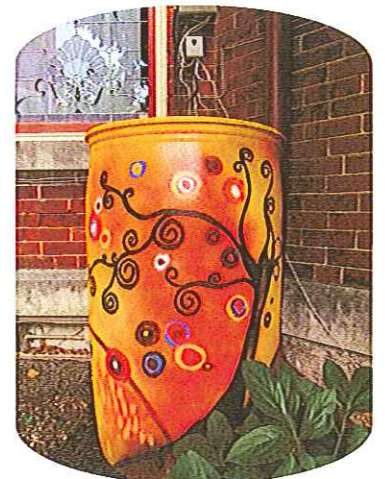
For businesses to participate there needs to be accessible rain gutters on the building and a re-use for the stormwater collected.

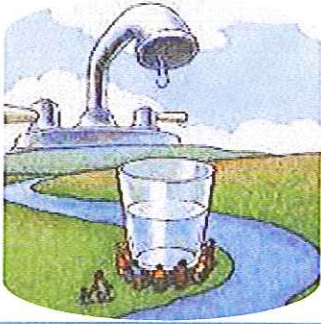
