

Leaf & Brush Collection **City Code (Chapter 300-Article III)**

Five (5) Municipal Districts have been established for the purpose of collecting leaves, small brush, and tree limbs. A map of these districts is available at the Public Works Main Office located at 91 Florida Avenue or call (856) 455-3030 x279 to request a map, district information or for leaf and brush collection information.

Brush, Limbs or Branches Pick-Up: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY****

Brush, limbs or branches are collected year round on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month by appointment only. No yellow sticker is required.

- No branches or limbs more than 6” in diameter will be collected
- No trees, logs, stumps, roots or bushes with roots will be accepted
- Small brush should be bundled & tied not to exceed 30 lbs. in weight
- Small vines and yard vegetation should be in clear plastic bags (not to exceed 30 gallon capacity)
- Call the Public Works office at (856) 455-3230 X279 Monday-Friday 7:30AM-3:00PM to schedule an appointment. If you get a recording, please leave your name, address & phone number and a representative will return your call to confirm your appointment.
- **DO NOT place limbs at curbside until you have a confirmed appointment! Failure to adhere to this policy may result in a violation and fine.**
- No item for collection can be placed at the curbside before the Saturday prior to the scheduled appointment day.
- Please note that your pickup may be rescheduled due to inclement weather, equipment failure or other unforeseen circumstances.

Leaves & Yard Vegetation: No appointment necessary

Leaves and small yard vegetation, excluding grass clippings are picked up on the 1st and 3rd full week of each month by district on the monthly schedule as outlined below. No yellow sticker is required.

Refer to the map and schedule below to see which district you are in and when to expect collection.

January 1st- March 30th: LEAVES & YARD VEGETATION **NOT** COLLECTED

April 1st - September 30th: BAGGED LEAVES & BAGGED YARD VEGETATION

- Picked up on the 1st and 3rd full week of each month by district
- Place leaves and small brush or yard vegetation in **clear** plastic bags only (not to exceed 30 gallon capacity)
- No grass clippings will be accepted (Place in clear plastic bags and put out with household trash only)
- No items for collection can be placed at the curbside before the Saturday prior to the scheduled collection day.

October 1st - December 31st: LOOSE LEAVES ONLY-NO YARD VEGETATION

- Picked up on the 1st and 3rd full week of each month by district
- Place LOOSE LEAVES IN GUTTERS as close to the curb line as possible but not closer than 10 feet to any storm drains
- No item for collection can be placed at the curbside before the Saturday prior to the scheduled collection day

Grass Clippings: Place in clear plastic bags and dispose of with household trash. No yellow sticker required.
