Because of the COVID-19 Pandemic, Bridgeton City Offices and Facilities will be closed to the public effective 4:30 pm 3/17/20. Below is listing of departments and links to department webpages that can provide residents with the ability to download needed forms and applications. Residents with the ability to submit forms and application electronically via email are encouraged to do so. For residents without the ability to submit via email, submissions can be made through regular mail or via drop-off through the Tax Office window, but residents are strongly encouraged to call the appropriate department first before using the tax window. Please check the City website often as guidance may change as conditions warrant.
