

TRASH AND RECYCLABLE PICK-UP DELAYS
JANUARY 10TH

TO BRIDGETON RESIDENTS

Please be advised that the Atlantic County Utilities Authority (ACUA) is working to resolve delays in pick-up of trash and recyclables in the neighborhoods throughout Bridgeton.

Recent pick-up delays are a result of labor shortages and scheduling difficulties caused by the recent surge in Covid-related illnesses impacting employee health. The resulting staffing shortages mean that trash pick-up schedules are behind in some instances by 2 to 3 days.

We apologize for any inconvenience these shortages may be causing for residents.

When delays occur, residents are asked to keep their trash and recyclable containers at curbside and when necessary, place properly bagged excess trash next to their containers and all trash will be removed.

Certain solid waste enforcement has been suspended until further notice while these issues are being resolved.
